Hello, my name is /last name and first name/ and I represent the Caucasus Research Resource Centers, a non-profit independent research center which is a program of the Eurasia Foundation in /country/. We are conducting our annual household survey and would like to ask your household a number of questions to help better understand people's opinions and conditions in the country. Your household has been selected randomly, along with a couple thousand other households in /country/, and it is very important for the reliability of the results that you agree to participate in this survey.

This interview is split into two parts. In the first part we would like to talk to those adult household members 18 and over who are home and involved in running the household. This part should take approximately 35 minutes, depending on the size of your household. In the second part, we need to select one household member randomly and speak to this person separately. If possible, we will conduct these two interviews at the same time.

All of your responses are voluntary and will be confidential and completely anonymous. Your name will not be linked to the responses recorded on this survey, nor will researchers be able to link your identity or address to the responses recorded. You have the right to refuse the interview, however, I ask you to help me do my work to help us understand what is going on in the country.
